

Z'Analyze has been tested to work with Windows XP, Win7 and Win8, Win 10, Win 11.

Z'Analyze can communicate with both Trewmac and Tomco TE1000, as well as Trewmac TE3000 and TE3001. It can also open files captured using Tomco and Trewmac RF impedance analyzer software. Once a file has been opened in *Z'Analyze*, it cannot be re-opened in the Tomco/Trewmac software.

To install *Z'Analyze*, simply drag it to your applications folder, and if desired, create a shortcut.

Software version 1.10 was released April 2023, and the manual can be found at <https://www.ftsplasma.com/manuals>.

When you open Z'Analyze, please use the following procedure to obtain the license file to activate the software:

- 1) If license.txt is not found, or if any error has occurred, the "About" window will display a description of the error.
- 2) It will also display the PC fingerprint of the computer. You can select and copy this text manually, or simply click, "Copy to clipboard".
- 3) Email this PC Fingerprint to crtech@ftsplasma.com.
- 4) We will generate a license key for your specific computer and then email it back to you.
- 5) Put the license.txt file in the same directory as *Z'Analyze.exe*.
- 6) When this has been done, open *Z'Analyze*.
- 7) If the license is found and is valid, the program simply starts without the "About" window and will work on that computer until the expiration date. License file duration and type will depend on the type of license purchased; if this is a permanent license, there will not be an expiration date listed.
